Would you like to enjoy some quality time with your family in a beautiful outdoor setting? Have we got an opportunity for you! We invite you to participate in Camp LuWiSoMo's Pastor of the Week (POW), Nurse of the Week (NOW), or Cook of the Week (COW) Programs.

Simply fill out the registration form on the left and complete the requirements on the right. In return, each Pastor, Nurse and Cook will receive free room and board, use of the facilities, and each child may attend that week of camp with a \$100 discount. If another week of camp is selected for the child, a \$50 discount would apply.



The Pastor of the Week Program is designed to enhance the Summer Camp Program at LuWiSoMo and at the same time allow for LC-MS Pastors to enjoy quality time with their families. The responsibilities of the POW include:



- 1) Lead our Saturday evening service - with a sermon.
- 2) Share an object lesson at four of our five morning chapel sessions during the week - these lessons should reflect our summer camp theme - "We Are One" Ephesians 4:4-6.
- 3) Lead 3 Bible studies (It can be the same one done three times if you like). One each for three groups: Youth Camp Counselors, Handicap & Servant Event Counselors, and Staff in Training.

Nurses of the Week

We need two nurses for most weeks. We ask that you split the duties of being our "nurse-in-residence" for the week. One nurse will always be on-call. You would be in charge of collecting and dispensing medications that the campers need to take, according to their doctor's prescription. We also ask that you participate in camper registration on Saturday and Sunday afternoons, so that you have the opportunity to meet with the parents of those campers who require medication during the week. If any camper should require serious medical care, there is a hospital located just 5 miles from LuWiSoMo.



Cook of the Week

If you are interested in becoming one of our assistant Cooks, (we need one cook for each week), we ask that you would work with the regular cook for two meals a day. It could be breakfast and lunch, lunch and supper, or breakfast and supper. We ask you to help with food preparation, clean-up, and serving. We also ask you to help keep the LuWiSoMo food service operation running smoothly. It is our goal to give preference to homemade foods and serve tasty meals to our campers. You can eat with you family when they come in if you like.

Additional Information

One or two rooms will be set aside for you, depending on the size of your family (four people per room). Each room has two bunk beds, and you will need to bring bedding for you and your family.

Arrival and departure times vary depending on which week you sign up for. Normal check-in time for Pastors is Sunday and check-out time is after the Saturday evening worship service. Normal check-in time/check-out time for Nurses and Cooks is Saturday mid-day. All can stay Saturday night if you like. Please check the schedule for date of camp information.

At the end of the week, Pastors, Nurses, and Cooks are also asked to clean and prepare the facilities they have used for the week. This will allow the new arrival of volunteers to more efficiently begin their exciting week.

You and your family are welcome to participate in any of the activities during the week, or just relax and enjoy LuWiSoMo.
