

LuWiSoMo Guidelines

1. Camp LuWiSoMo is a Christian camp. We expect everyone who uses our facilities to conduct themselves in a Christian manner. Foul language will not be tolerated. In every situation, ask yourself, "W.W.J.D.?"
2. When a chaperon/staff person puts his/her hand up, put your hand up and listen quietly.
3. Quiet hours are from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. At "Lights Out," everyone is to be in their rooms with their lights out.
4. Do not enter any room/cabin unless you have been invited.
5. No guys in girls' rooms/cabins. No girls in guys' rooms/cabins.
6. No littering. Put recyclables in their place. Containers are marked for paper/cardboard, glass/plastic, and aluminum cans. Unmarked containers are for all other garbage.
7. No eating in sleeping areas.
8. Wear shoes while walking around camp.
9. If you are the last one out of a cabin or room, turn out the light. Any lights persistently left on with nobody present will be removed.
10. Respect camp property. Please report any damage immediately to the camp staff. Intentional or careless damage will be charged to the people responsible.
11. Never throw rocks, sand, etc.
12. Screens should never be removed from any windows (except in an emergency).
13. Youth should never leave camp property unless they are with their counselor/chaperon.
14. Minors are not allowed at the waterfront without an adult present.
15. Clean up after yourself. Leave LuWiSoMo looking better than it did when you arrived.
16. No alcohol, fireworks, or weapons of any kind are allowed on Camp LuWiSoMo property.
17. Shoes must be removed upon entering the chapel.
18. No food or drink is allowed in the chapel.

Anyone failing to follow these guidelines will be asked to leave.
