### Horse-A-Piece

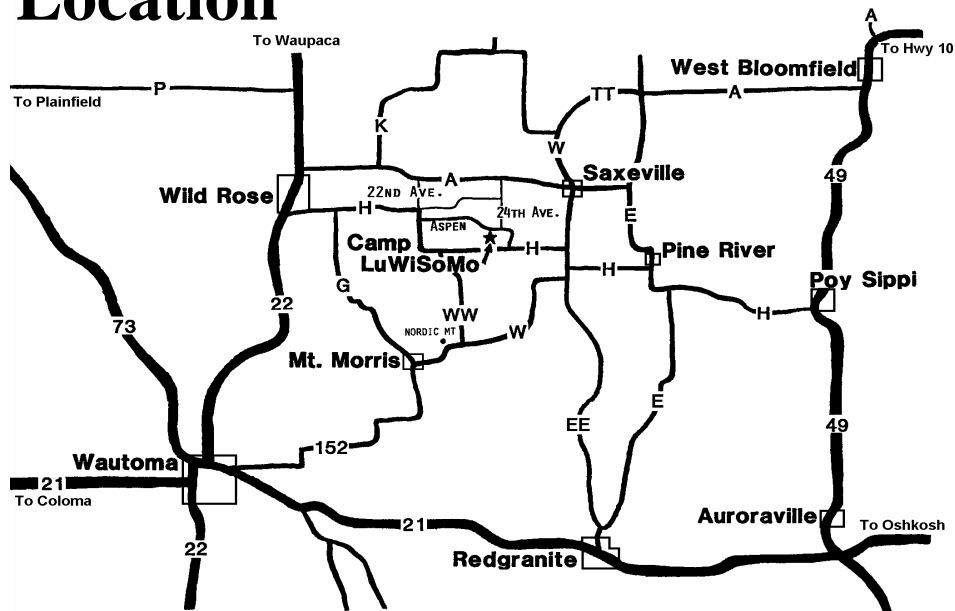

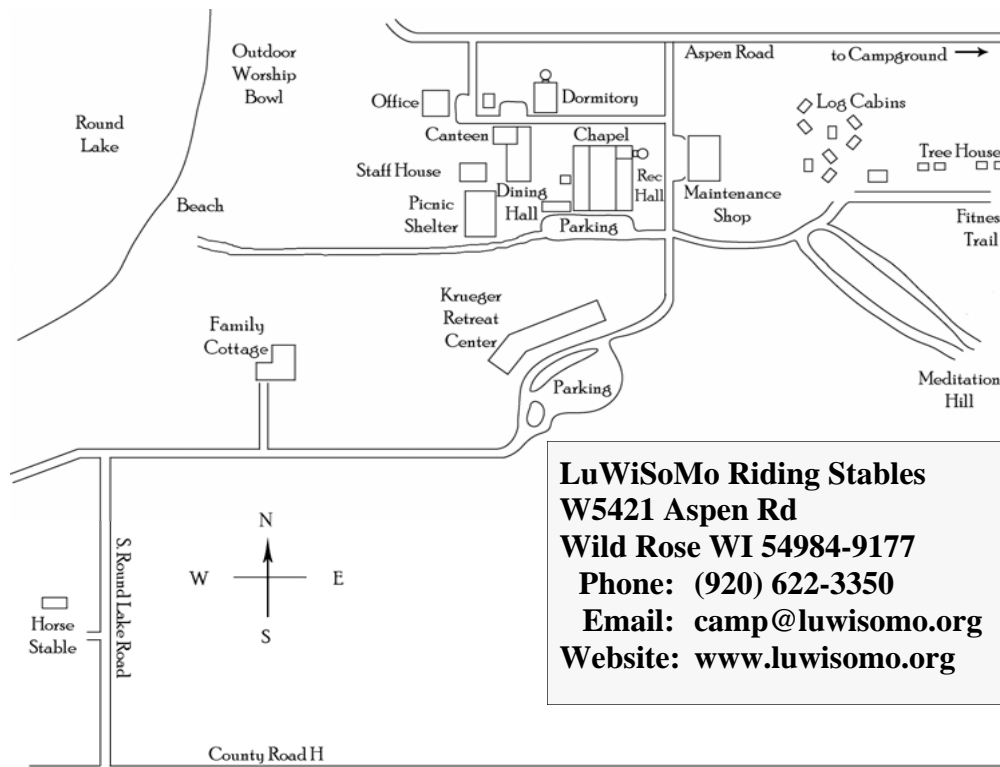

Aspen East to **Camp LuWiSoMo** (1.9 miles)

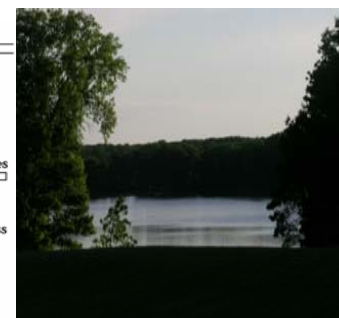
**FROM MILWAUKEE, FOND DU LAC, & OSHKOSH**

**Rules for riding at LuWiSoMo**

1. Reservation is required at least one hour in advance. All 7:30 p.m. rides must be reserved by 3:00 p.m. of that day. (Rides may be canceled due to weather. Full refund will be given.)
  2. Must be at least eight years old for the 45-minute trail ride.
  3. All riders must sign a waiver at time of payment. Riders under 18 must have a parent or guardian sign the waiver.
  4. Please wear appropriate attire (i.e. long pants, and fully enclosed shoes). No riding will be permitted if wearing sandals or clogs.
  5. Helmets are required (provided by LuWiSoMo Stables).
  6. Please arrive early. Rides are not guaranteed for late arrivals.
  7. All reservations and payments should be made through the camp office. (920) 622-3350
  8. Advanced payment or credit card must be presented at the time of reservation.

**NOTICE  
WISCONSIN LAW  
PROVIDES:**

...A participant in a recreational activity...accepts the risk inherent in the recreational activity of which the ordinary prudent person is or should be aware.

1. Act within the limits of his or her ability.
