

LuWiSoMo Campground Rules:

This campground is owned and operated by Camp LuWiSoMo, Inc., an R.S.O. of the Lutheran Church, Missouri Synod.

- Check In time is 3 p.m. Check Out time is noon.
- Campground speed limit is 5 mph. If a vehicle is leaving a dust trail it is traveling too fast.
- Quiet Time is 10 p.m. – 8 a.m.
- Noise—Please keep all radios, TV's and boom boxes at a reasonable sound level.
- Dogs must be on a leash. You must control the barking of your dog. They are not to be left unattended. Owners are responsible for clean-up. Pets are not allowed in the cabins, shower house or any other building at Camp LuWiSoMo.
- Do not remove picnic tables from other sites.
- No more than two vehicles are allowed per campsite. Additional vehicles may be parked in the common area East of the Shower house.
- There can be no more than one camping unit per site. The only exception is a tent set up only for minor children when the parents occupy the same site.
- Campfires must be kept inside the designated fire rings. Fires must be extinguished upon your departure or as you retire at night.
- Mini bikes, ATV's, off Road vehicles, Chain Saws, Firearms and Fireworks are not allowed in the campground.
- Generators shall not be used at any time.
- Please put all garbage in bags and take to the dumpsters at the campground entrance.
- Smoking is prohibited in any building, including the cabins.
- Do not use the rest rooms for cleaning dishes, clothing or fish.
- Do not dump Port-A-Potties in the rest room. Use the dump station for this purpose.
- Grey Water must be contained and disposed of at the dump station. DHS 178.13(2) (e).
- No electrical appliances are allowed to be used in the shower facilities except for personal hygiene.
- Responsible use of alcohol is permitted at your site only. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the main camp or at the waterfront.

Anyone not willing to comply with our rules will be asked to leave immediately without refund.

Please know that you are welcome here at Camp LuWiSoMo and that your patronage is appreciated. Have fun and enjoy your stay with us.
