

Camp LuWiSoMo CIT FAQs

How old do I need to be to apply to be a CIT?

You must currently be in High School (9th Grade) to apply. CITs in their first year of High School (9th grade) are only eligible to serve as a CIT for Joyful Hearts camps. CITs in the 10th grade or older may serve as a CIT for Joyful Hearts or youth camps.

Do I need to apply again if I was a CIT in the past?

Yes, you need to apply (complete a new application) each year you would like to participate in the program.

What is the process to apply and sign up for training?

Step 1 - Complete the application processes. This includes submitting the application form and the additional information indicated on the form (Personal Letter of Application and two references).

Step 2 - This happens if you are accepted as a CIT for this summer. You will be asked to complete the Payment & Waivers Form and the Health History Form.

When can I apply?

Applications are considered on a rolling basis as they are received. Applications should be submitted no later than the first part of April. If after that date, please contact us.

Do I need to attend training to serve?

Yes. This is an important weekend for leadership training and team building.

Do I need to attend training if I've been a CIT and attended in the past?

Yes.

What week(s) will I serve during the summer and when will I know?

You indicate your availability on your application. In June, once all the summer camp registrations are in, we will make CIT assignments for the whole summer and let you know when you will serve.

Am I paid to be a CIT?

CITs are volunteers. We provide your meals and housing during the time you are assigned to serve, but there is no additional pay.
