



Campground Rules

Check-In 3:00 pm | Check-Out Noon | Quiet Hours 10:00 pm – 8:00 am

Campers must be 21 or older to reserve campsites or cabins.

Campsites - Limit 1 camping unit and no more than 6 people per campsite. The only exception is that a second tent for minor children may be added when their parents occupy the same campsite.

Cabins - Limit 5 people. No Smoking. Not Pets.

Limit 2 vehicles per campsite or cabin. Additional vehicles may be parked in the common area by the shower house.

Speed limit 5 mph. If a vehicle leaves a dust trail, it is traveling too fast.

To maintain a peaceful environment for all guests, all music, TVs and conversations shall be kept at a reasonable sound level, as determined by camp staff. If you are not at your campsite, audio equipment should be turned off. Generators may not be used at any time.

Excessive noise, drunkenness, foul language, immoral and illegal conduct will not be tolerated. Police will be notified and you will be asked to leave without a refund.

Pets

- Pets must be on a leash at all times and shall not be left unattended.
- Pets are not allowed in cabins, shower houses, playground, or any other camp buildings.
- No exotic or unusual animals allowed.
- Owner is responsible for clean-up of all their pet's droppings.
- Owner is responsible to control their dog's barking so as not to disturb other guests.
- Pets must be of good nature with strangers. Any incidents between a person and your pet, or your pet and another pet, must be reported to camp staff. Owners of the pet will be held responsible for any actions or charges from these incidents.

Campfires are only allowed within the designated fire rings and must be fully extinguished if you leave the campsite and when you retire at night.

Firewood is for sale at the camp store or from the campground host. Scavenging for firewood or cutting trees or underbrush is not permitted.

Nailing or screwing into trees is not permitted.

The picnic table may not be moved from the campsite, or tables from other sites moved to your site.

Generators, mini-bikes, ATVs, off-road vehicles, chainsaws, firearms and fireworks are not allowed.

Smoking is prohibited in any buildings, including the cabins.

Restrooms / Shower Houses may not be used for cleaning dishes, clothing, or fish. No electrical appliances may be used in the shower facilities except for personal hygiene.

Portable toilets may not be dumped in the restroom. Use the dump station for that purpose.

No dumping gray water or waste water (including dishwater) on the ground. Use the dump station for disposal.

Responsible use of alcohol, as determined by camp staff, is permitted at your campsite only. No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the campground common areas, main camp or at the waterfront.

Clean Up / Cleaning Fee

- All trash must be bagged and placed in the dumpsters or taken with you.
- A \$50 per hour (\$50 minimum) charge will be applied for any excessive clean-up required, if the campsite or cabin is not left clean, in the same condition as when you arrived. This includes cigarette butts, food scraps, water balloon remnants and trash left at the site.

This property is privately owned. Campers accept privileges with the understanding that they hereby release Camp LuWiSoMo, its officers and employees, of all liability for loss or damage and agree to indemnify such against claims resulting from loss or damage to property or injury of themselves or their guests arising out of the use of the camp.

Anyone not willing to comply with these rules will be asked to leave immediately without a refund.
