## **Dress & Behavior**

Camp LuWiSoMo is a family-friendly Christian community.

To maintain this environment, we expect that your language, dress, and behavior are appropriate for this community.

At no time should campers wear clothing that shows their undergarments. Avoid short or tight shirts, short shorts, and clothes that reference drugs, alcohol, or have inappropriate innuendos. Girls are asked to wear one piece bathing suits at camp.

### **Canteen Money**

Each day campers have an opportunity to buy snacks at the Canteen. Canteen Money is collected at Check-In and deposited into their Canteen Account. Any remaining balance is available for pick up before they leave.

We recommend \$20. Cash or check (payable to Camp LuWiSoMo) preferred. Credit / Debit cards accepted, but an approximate 3% processing fee is added. Returned balances will be in cash.
