With all the changes over the last decade, many of the needed infrastructure upgrades and property and facility work were unable to be addressed. However, that has changed, and your gifts are what is driving that progress. We still have a way to go, but as your gifts are received, we're putting them right to work.

These are some highlights of what's been completed this year and what's in the works. See last Fall's newsletter, on the website, for projects completed in 2020.

Know that while these investments are necessary and some are big, we're pacing them as gifts are received to ensure maintaining financial health and proper reserves.

Campground

Grounds work and improvements continued, playground equipment was repaired, and new swings added. New exterior windows and sealed doors are in process for the older Pine Shower House, and a "master plan" including site upgrades, group site areas, picnic shelters and other improvements are in the works.

Chapel & New "Gathering Area"

The Shepherd's House is gone and demo of the old dining hall is up next - making way for a "Chapel Courtyard" and "Gathering Area". A large, graveled parking area behind the Chapel was added to serve the Chapel, Gathering Area, and Waterfront. Additional parking along the service road in front of the old dining hall and Shepherd's House is planned, along with Picnic Shelter improvements.

Retreat Center

The new water treatment & plumbing equipment is being installed. Meeting Room renovations continue, including new exterior windows, LED lighting, LVP flooring, paint, and furnishings. The old fire alarm system was replaced. Internet / WiFi upgraded. New LED lighting for the rooms and hall is being installed, and door hardware replaced. Room window replacement is planned. The lower level is being converted back to a guest game/activity space. The new exterior windows are already installed. A future outdoor patio area off this lower level is planned.

Waterfront

We've worked with authorities to expand the swimming and beach area and fill in the low area behind the beach with some of this becoming more beach area. A new, larger, relocated boat house is planned along with a few designated "drop off / pick-up" parking spots, sand volleyball court, and picnic area. The goal is a beautiful, natural, functional waterfront area large enough for all guests and activities, including full camp campfires and worship under a large cross.

Youth & Family Cabins

All cabins have new porches, new sealed fiberglass doors and door hardware. New windows, doors, ventilation system, septic system, and interior improvements are in process for the Shower House. LED lighting and exterior cleaning, sealing, and staining are planned for all cabins and the shower house, along with adding designated parking and some landscaping.

Other

The Maintenance Building LeanTo was cleaned out and organized for storing split wood, boats, and our tractor, with a bay set up for wood splitting. Cameras have been added throughout the property for safety and security. A campaign is being launched to replace the rotting wood picnic tables with aluminum tables (200 tables). Also in the works is a full master "campus" development plan to address future needs and guide development, including interconnecting walking trails throughout the property, a new, relocated maintenance facility, addition of an activity center/gym, and more family-style housing.
