

# Summer Camp COVID-19 Protocols

May 2022

These protocols are intended to ensure LuWiSoMo has done its best to provide reasonable COVID-19 safety for all campers, volunteers, and staff, and complies with applicable CDC, federal, state, and local requirements for overnight camps.

LuWiSoMo follows the CDC recommended prevention steps based on the COVID-19 Community Level to respond to changing conditions. A change from the current “low” or “medium” levels to “high” may require stricter COVID protocols.

## Summer Camp Protocols for Low & Medium Community Level

These protocols apply to all LuWiSoMo summer camp campers, volunteers, staff, and guests.

1. All are encouraged to stay up to date with COVID-19 vaccines.
2. **Beginning 10 days prior to arrival at camp**, monitor health for COVID-19 symptoms (*see CDC website for COVID-19 symptom details*).

### Symptoms Present or Suspected Exposure

If COVID-19 symptoms are present, or you think there may have been exposure to COVID-19, consult with your health care professional. In addition, **a test with negative results is required** as close to arrival as possible - no more than 36 hours prior to arrival. A rapid “self” or “home” test is acceptable.

### No Symptoms

Testing is not required if COVID-19 symptoms are not present.

3. If COVID-19 symptoms develop while at camp, a rapid test will be required. A negative result is required to remain at camp. A positive result will require the camper to leave immediately. The camper will be held in quarantine to allow reasonable time for pickup.
4. Masks are not required. However, we are committed to ensuring a welcoming environment for all who choose to wear a mask during their time at camp.
5. All campers, volunteers, staff, and guests must sign the **Summer Camp COVID-19 Self-Screening & Release Form**, certifying compliance with these protocols. If unwilling or unable to comply, they cannot attend camp.
